



2022 Fall School Tours

As you plan activities for your students this fall, we hope you will consider Parlee Farms for your school trip. We offer the best that New England farms have to offer - fresh fruit for you to pick which has been grown in an environmentally safe way, a scenic hayride around our 93-acre farm, young farm animals to feed, use of our picnic area, a large indoor restroom facility, and more!

Our farm tours are geared for pre-school through 3rd grade children. For fall school trips, we offer three packages with an age-appropriate explanation of our farming techniques on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.

Apple Trip (available September 20 – October 20, Tuesday - Thursday from 9am-11:30am)

- **\$7.00 per person** (minimum 20 paying people per reservation)
- 1/4-peck bag for apple picking
- All of the activities listed below
- This trip takes about 1 hour to complete – please allow more time for large groups.

Pumpkin Trip (available October 12 – October 20, Tuesday - Thursday from 9am-11:30am)

- **\$7.00 per person** (minimum 20 paying people per reservation)
- A small Sugar Pumpkin picked from our Pumpkin Patch & a bag for the child to carry the pumpkin home
- All of the activities listed below
- This trip takes about 1 hour to complete – please allow more time for large groups.

Combination Trip (available September 20 – October 20, Tues - Thursday from 9am-12pm)

- **\$8.50 per person** (minimum 20 paying people per reservation)
- 1/4-peck bag for apple picking
- A small Sugar Pumpkin picked from our Pumpkin Patch & a bag for the child to carry the pumpkin home
- All of the activities listed below
- This trip takes about 1-1/2 hours to complete – please allow more time for large groups.

Activities included in all the Trips

- Hayride around the farm
- Feed for Annie's 'Goats in the Trees' and for our other goats, sheep, and bunnies
- Use of our Picnic Area
- Paid school staff (1 for every 10 students) can pick the same amount as the children without charge.
- All children are required to pay.
- Non-picking adults are welcome on the trip at no cost. If chaperones want to pick, the cost will be the same as for the children.

OPTIONS ~

- **Apple Cider Donuts** - our very popular mini donuts made before your eyes!
 - \$0.75 each ~ please reserve at least two days before your trip
- **Apple Cider & Apple Cider Donut** ~ small cup of pasteurized apple cider and our apple cider mini donut
 - \$1.25 per person ~ please reserve at least two days before your trip

FALL SCHOOL TOUR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Prior to arriving at the farm:

- We need a final count two weeks before your trip. On the day of the trip, we will only charge you for the students that are on the trip (once the minimum is met).
- If you have multiple classes, please send us each teacher's name and number of students and picking chaperones in each class when you submit your final numbers. We will separate the packages by teacher prior to your arrival to make everything go more smoothly.
- Please let us know if there are any children that require special accommodations when booking your trip so we can allow extra time if necessary.
- We require one chaperone for every five children.
- We will accept one payment from each group either by Cash (large bills only), School Check (no personal checks accepted), MasterCard, Visa, or Discover. The payment should cover all picking children and adults, including parent chaperones that are picking.
- Please bring labels with the children's' names on them to place on each child's picking bag or bring markers to write on the bags.
- For large groups, please plan to separate into groups of 30 people to assist in loading the hayride.
- All children should dress appropriately for outdoor activities.

What if it rains?

- Parlee Farms will make a decision no later than 7am on the day of the trip to cancel and reschedule. We review multiple weather sources and if it appears that there will be rain at the farm between 9am-2pm, we will cancel. This is an outdoor trip and we do not have enough indoor space to accommodate a large number of people to wait out a storm.
- Notification will be posted by 7am on our website www.parleefarms.com under "Today's Farm News", on our Facebook Page www.facebook.com/parleefarms, and on our outgoing phone message at 978-649-3854. Teachers and parents should check one of these on the day of the trip.
- Teachers will be contacted by email during the day to reschedule.

On the day of your trip:

- Please arrive at the farm 15 minutes prior to your start time. Trips are scheduled to leave every 15 minutes.
- The adult in charge should check in and pay at the farmstand prior to the start of the trip for all picking children and adults (this includes parent chaperones that are picking). The adult in charge should know the exact number of students, teachers, paying adults, and non-paying adults on the trip.
- The children and other adults should remain on the bus where they will receive a welcoming from a member of the farm staff and an explanation of the day's events.
